SOLACTIVE GLOBAL SUPERDIVIDEND V2 INDEX

SELECTION

- The index is designed to track the performance of companies that exhibit a high dividend yield.
- Companies must have no official announcement, as of the selection date, that dividend payments will be cancelled or significantly reduced in the future.
- The maximum number of constituents is 100.

SELECTION POOL


- Eligible companies must have:
 - Share Class Market Capitalization of at least \$500 million.
 - Average Daily Turnover of at least \$1 million over the last three months.
 - Primary listing in a Developed Market or Emerging Market (excluding India, China, and Argentina).
 - Companies may have a dividend yield of at least 6% and less than 20%, if they are not current constituents, and at least 3% if they are current constituents.
 - Traded on 90% of the eligible trading days for the previous 6 months.
 - Free Float percentage of total shares outstanding of at least 10% or a minimum Free Float Market Capitalization of \$1 billion.
 - No Closed End Fund, Business Development Companies (BDCs), Partnership (both Qualified Publicly Traded Partnership and non-qualified Partnership) or Trust.

WEIGHTING SCHEME

- Index components are weighted equally.
- The maximum aggregated weight of index constituents listed on a Russian stock exchange is 10%.

REBALANCING

- Annual rebalance occurs over a rolling 5-day period beginning on the last business day of February. Quarterly reviews occurs over a rolling 5-day period beginning on the last business day of May, August and November.
